Online Applications are invited from eligible candidates as per criteria given below for filling up the vacancies against Scouts & Guides Quota of Eastern Railway, Chittaranjan Locomotive Works (CLW) and Metro Railway for the year 2026-27 for Five (05) posts in Level-2 (Group 'C') & for Ten (10) posts in Level-1 (Erstwhile Group 'D') category. **The candidates having no Scouts & Guides Qualifications need not apply.** The details are given below:

3. ESSENTIAL EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

Category	<u>ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION</u> (Minimum Educational Qualification & Scouting/Guiding Qualification)
Level – 2 (Group 'C')	1. 4. The candidates may apply for Pay Level-1(erstwhile Group 'D') or Pay Level-2 (Group 'C') (7thCPC) or "Both". Candidates willing to apply for both the categories should fill forms separately for each category. Examination fee, as applicable, has to be paid separately for both the categories.

5. SCOUTING/GUIDING QUALIFICATION (FOR LEVEL-2 AND LEVEL-1 BOTH CATEGORIES):

In addition to Essential Qualifications mentioned at Para 3, the following qualification of Scouts & Guides will be applicable for both Level-2 and Level-1 posts (7th CPC):

- A President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger OR Himalayan Wood Badge (HWB) holder in any section;
- Should have been an active member of Scout Organization for the last 5 years. The 'Certificate of Activeness' should be as per Annexure– VIII; and
- Should have attended two events at National level OR All Indian Railways' level AND two events at State Level.

6. RESERVATION:

This quota is open to all candidates and candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/ESM/PwBD categories who apply against notification published for this quota be extended relaxation in age limit as admissible in a general open market recruitment. However, in case of being selected with any relaxation on account of being a candidate from the above categories, he/she will be taken against reserve roster point.

7. AGE LIMIT: (THE AGE WILL BE RECKONED AS ON 01.01.2027)

- PROOF OF AGE:** The candidate has to submit either a Birth Certificate issued by Registrar of Births or 10th class Certificate or 10th class Admit card or Mark Sheet indicating date of birth, issued by a government recognized Education Board as proof of age.

NOTE: The date of birth filled in the application form should be same as recorded in the Matriculation/SSLC/Xth Class or an equivalent certificate. No subsequent request for its change will be considered. The candidate must upload a scanned self-attested copy of the birth certificate or 10th class Certificate or 10th class Admit card or Mark Sheet indicating date of birth issued by a government recognized Education Board during filling up of online application and produce the original certificate during document verification.

8. EXTENT OF AGE RELAXATION:

- Serving Railway employees, including casual labourers, who have put in minimum three years of continuous service and substitutes, who have put in minimum three years of continuous service or minimum three years in broken spells in the Railways have following relaxation: Maximum Age – for both Level-1 & Level-2, UR - 40yrs., OBC – 43 yrs., SC/ST – 45 yrs.
- Widows/Divorced women and Women judicially separated but not re-married. Maximum age- for both Level-1 & Level-2, UR – 35yrs., OBC-38yrs., SC/ST-40 yrs.

Persons with benchmark disabilities (PwBDs): Age relaxation of 10 yrs. is applicable in addition to Para 7 (Subject to production of Disability Certificate to be issued by at least three (03) Members' committee of a Govt. Hospital).

- The Upper age limit is relaxable for Ex-servicemen up to the extent of service rendered in Defense Forces plus 3 years provided they have put in a minimum of 6 months attested service. Ex-servicemen, who have already joined the Govt. Service on Civil side after availing other benefits given to them as Ex-servicemen for further employment, cannot claim Ex-servicemen status for the purpose of this recruitment, such a person will be deemed to be civil employee and will accordingly be entitled to only such of the benefits like relaxation of age, etc. as admissible to Civil Employees, in the normal course in accordance with the existing instructions in this regard, subject to his fulfillment of the conditions governing the grant of such benefits.

- iv. The staff of Quasi-Administrative offices or organizations such as Railway Consumer Co-operative Societies, Canteens and Institutes etc. will be given relaxation in age limit to the extent of 05 years or service rendered in such organization, whichever is less.
- v. For Course Completed Act Apprentices (CCAA), applying for Level-1 posts age limit will be 33 years for UR candidates, 36 years for OBC candidates and 38 years for SC/ST candidates plus the upper age limit may be relaxed to the extent of Apprentice Training undergone by them under the Apprentice Act, 1961, subject to maximum of three (3) years.

9. RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

Candidates, who apply in response to the notification issued and found eligible after scrutiny, will be Assessed as follows:

I. FOLLOWING STAGES WOULD BE INVOLVED THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

A. STAGE-I

Written Test	60 Marks
The written test will consist of 40 Objective type questions (40 marks) & 01 essay type question (20 marks) relating to Scouts & Guides Organization and its activities and General knowledge for Level-2 and Level-1 (7thCPC). Duration of Written Test is 60minutes. The syllabus for this will be as per- Para-9.VII Only on qualifying Stage-I, the candidate would be eligible for Stage-II. However, for Stage-II, candidates would be called in the ratio of 1:3 of notified vacancy as per the merit order in Stage-I.	Minimum Qualifying percentage 40%

- II. Special Courses for Leaders of Adults shall be governed as per Scheme of Training (SOT) prescribed by The Bharat Scouts and Guides.
- III. The candidates must choose anyone of the following Languages for the purpose of written examination only: **Hindi or English.**
- IV. After clearing Stage-I and Stage-II and after recommendation of the Recruitment Committee, the candidate would be sent for medical examination at Railway Hospital as per MERIT ORDER in the ratio of 1:1 of Notified vacancies. It is mandatory for such a candidate to be declared fit in the prescribed medical category, by Railway Medical Authority, as applicable for the offered post.

- V. The time and venue of Written Examination, Verification of Scouts & Guides and Educational Qualification Certificates will be fixed by RRC/ER and will be intimated to the eligible candidates in due course. No request for postponement of written examination/Document Verification of Scouts & Guides Certificates and Educational Qualification Certificates will be entertained under any circumstances.
- VI. The call letter download facility for recruitment stages would be made available tentatively 15 days before the written test. Call letter will not be sent by post. Hence, candidate should check the website of RRC/ER regularly.

VII. SYLLABUS FOR THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION: LEVEL-1 (7TH CPC) AND LEVEL-2 (7TH CPC)

History of Scouting/Guiding; Law and Promise; Organisation- 'District & State Level'; Training Centre –Distt. & State Level; Knowledge of Books; Scouting for Boys/Guiding for Girls in India; Motto left hand shake; Salute; Prayer; Flag song; National Anthem; Know the National & Scouting flags; Social Services at various occasions; Hiking; Proficiency Badges, How these are earned?; Stages in Scouting/Guiding. Thinking Day; Progressive Training of Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Rangers; Pioneering; Handicrafts; Indian Railway Jamborette; National Jamboree; Jamboree on the Air.

Organization at National Level; National Training Centers, WAGGGS/WOSM- Uprastrapati Award Competition; Prime Minister Shield Competition; Community Development Programmers; Aims and Methods of Scouting; How Scouting is useful in producing better citizens?

10. EXAMINATION FEES

- i. For all candidates except those mentioned in sub-para (10.ii) below - Rs.500/- (Rupees five Hundred only) with a provision for refunding **Rs. 400/-** (Rupees four hundred) to those who actually appear in the written examination. **(UR-Male, OBC-Male, EWS Male Rs.500/-)**
- ii. For candidates belonging to SC, ST, Ex-servicemen, PwBD, Women, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes, **Rs. 250/-** (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty) only with a provision for refunding the same to those who actually appear in the written examination. SC, ST, OBC, Economically Backward Classes and PwBD, ESM Discharge certificates must be enclosed as per Annexures attached in the Notification.
- iii. Candidates must upload relevant documents as per sub-para (10.ii) of this notification and produce originals at the time of Document Verification.
- iv. Examination fee should be paid online using Internet Banking or Debit Card or Credit Card or UPI (Service Charges for payment of fees will be borne by the candidates).
- v. Examination Fees in Cash/Cheque/Money Order/Central Recruitment Fee Stamps/Demand Draft will not be accepted and accordingly application will be rejected.
- vi. Candidates attending the Written Test shall be eligible for refund of the examination fee (Rs. 400/- or Rs. 250/-, as applicable). The refund shall be credited either to the original bank account used for payment during submission of the online application or to an alternative beneficiary bank account furnished by the candidate. For this purpose, candidates shall be required to provide beneficiary bank details, including account holder's name, account number, bank name, and IFSC code. The refundable portion of the examination fee shall be refunded after deduction of applicable bank charges and other charges, if any.
- vii. It is the candidate's sole responsibility to ensure that the provided beneficiary details including the name, account number, bank name, and IFSC code are accurate and that the account is active. The RRC cannot be held responsible for refunds that fail due to incorrect, invalid, or inactive account information.

Note:- • Minority will mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains and Zoroastrians Parsi.

- Economically Backward Classes will mean the candidates whose family income is less than Rs.50000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) per annum.

- viii. The EBC candidate should submit the Income Certificate issued by the authorities mentioned in **Annexure – VII**, and upload the same at the time of filling up the online application.

11. HOW TO APPLY

- i. Eligible candidates are required to go to the link provided for filling ONLINE application through the official website of RRC/ER (**www.rrcer.org**) and fill up the personal details/BIO-DATA carefully.
- ii. Candidates are advised to indicate their personal mobile no. and personal valid E-mail IDs in the ONLINE application and keep them active during the entire recruitment process for communicating with them.
- iii. Candidates should ensure that their Name/Spelling, Father's Name/Spelling, Community details, Educational Qualification and Date of Birth match with the entries recorded in Matriculation or equivalent certificate

In case there is significant deviation/difference in the Name/Spelling/DOB etc. in the documents of the candidate then his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled from the day the discrepancy is noticed. No claim would be entertained in this regard. Hence candidates are advised to thoroughly check their documents.

12. DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED:

i. PHOTOGRAPH:

- (a) It should be a color passport-size photograph with white/light color background. It should be of size 35mmX45mm or 320x240 pixels. It should be in JPG/JPEG format scanned with 100 DPI resolution. The size of the photograph should be between 20-50KB.
- (b) The color photograph must have been taken on or after publication of web notice in a professional studio. Photographs taken using mobile and self-composed portraits may result in rejection of application.
- (c) The photograph must match with the appearance of the candidate on the days of Written Test and Document Verification and Medical test.
- (d) The photo should have clear front view of the candidate without cap and sunglasses.
- (e) The face should occupy at least 50% of the area of the photograph with a full-face view looking at the camera directly. The main features of the face must not be covered by hair of the head any cloth or any shadow. Forehead, eyes, nose and chin should be clearly visible.
- (f) In case the candidate wears glasses, then the photograph should not have any glare/reflections on glasses and eyes should be clearly visible.
- (g) Photos of the candidates on all documents should be identical in all stages of recruitment process. Candidates are advised to keep at least 12 (Twelve) copies of the same photograph for further use, as and when required during the recruitment process.

ii. SIGNATURE AND LTI:

- (a) The applicant has to sign and put LTI on white paper with Black Ink within a box of size 50 mm x 20mm. The images should be in JPG/JPEG format scanned with 100 dpi resolution. Size of file should be between 10-40KB.
- (b) The signature and LTI must be of the applicant only and not of any other person otherwise it would be treated as impersonation/fraud. Candidate should then upload scanned photograph, Left Thumb Impression and signature in following manner. There should not be any smudge/non readable signature for Left Thumb Impression.
- (c) Signatures of the candidates on all documents should be identical in all stages of recruitment process. Signatures in different style at the time of Written Test, Document Verification, Medical examination etc. may result in cancellation of candidature.
- (d) Signature should be either in Hindi or English and must not be in **Capital** or Disjointed letter.

iii. OTHER DOCUMENTS:

- (a) **All Certificates and mark sheets which are proof of educational qualification and that of Scouts & Guides qualification, MUST BE DULY SELF ATTESTED and issued by Govt. recognized Board/University/Institute as per Para 3 & 5, should be uploaded along with the application form.**
- (b) At the time of DV, candidates must produce **original certificates** for educational and Scouts & Guides qualifications. If the original certificate is not available, the candidate may submit a final mark sheet along with a provisional certificate and an undertaking that the degree is awaited. However, offer of appointment will be kept pending until the original certificate is submitted or verified from the university. If even the final mark sheet is not produced, the candidature is liable to be rejected. Non-Submission of final certificate may result in cancellation of candidature.
- (c) **Self-attested** certificate in proof of age (Birth Certificate/Matriculation/10th certificate 10th/Admit card/10th Marksheet) indicating date of birth as per Para 7.
- (d) **SC/ST Candidate:** Candidates claiming to be SC and ST communities are required to upload self-attested community certificates issued by the Competent Authority with the online application as per the **Annexure-I**.
- (e) **OBC-NCL Candidate:** The OBC-NCL candidates should upload self-attested community certificate issued by the Competent Authority with the online application as per **Annexure-II**.
- (f) **OBC-NCL Candidate (Self Declaration):** The OBC-NCL candidates should also submit self-declaration as per **Annexure-IIA** indicating that the candidate does not belong to the Creamy layer.

- (g) **EBC Candidate:** Candidates claiming to belong to EBC are required to upload Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-VII** of this Notification.
- (h) **EWS Candidate:** Candidates claiming to belong to EWS are required to upload Income Certificate issued by the Competent Authority in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-VI** of this notification.
- (i) **Minority Candidates:** Candidates claiming to belong to Minority Community are required to upload a declaration for waiver of Examination fees as per **Annexure-IX** of this Notification.
- (j) **PwBD Candidate:** PwBD candidates have to submit self-attested Disability Certificate as per **Annexure-III, IV & V**.
- (k) Self-attested certificates in proof of **Scouts & Guides achievements** as per Notification.
- (l) Certificates in languages other than English or Hindi should be accompanied by an attested Translation in English/Hindi
- (m) **Those candidates who are finally qualified for appointment should submit (Annexure – III) as per Master Circular-7.**

13. STEPS TO SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION:

- i) Visit on the **Notice Board of official website RRC/ER Kolkata (www.rrcer.org)** of Eastern Railway>Railway Recruitment Cell. Click on “Online/E-Application for Scouts & Guides Quota /2025-26”. Click on the “New Registration” link.
- ii) Fill in the personal information viz. Name, Father’s name, Date of Birth, Community, e-mail Address and Mobile number. On submission of required details an e-mail/SMS will be received in the registered e-mail ID/Mobile number. Open inbox of your registered e-mail/SMS and note the registration number and password.
- iii) Login-using the Registration number & password sent in the e-mail/SMS.
- iv) Follow the instructions and complete the registration process step-by-step.
 - a) Upload the scanned copy of Photograph, Signature and LTI, **self-attested** certificates in proof of date of birth, education/technical qualifications and caste i.e., SC/ST/OBC/EBC/EWS, income certificate, self-declarations pertaining to the OBC candidates and minority community candidates and Scouts & Guides achievements.
 - b) Fill up the mandatory fields of Application form.
- v) During submission of ONLINE application, a Unique Application Number will be generated and issued to each candidate. Candidates are advised to preserve/note their Registration Number for further stages of recruitment process/correspondence.
- vi) To avoid last minute rush, candidates are advised in their own interest to register and submit ONLINE application much before the closing date since there may be a possibility of inability/failure to log on to the website of RRC concerned on account of heavy load on the internet or website during last days of online registration.
- vii) Candidates should note that applications received directly by RRC/ER will not be entertained.
- viii) No change whatsoever will be entertained after final submission of online application and hard copy should be the same as submitted online.
- ix) Submit the properly filled up application form. Take 2 copies of print out of properly filled up application form.
- x) Candidates should have their own mobile number, valid & active personal email-id and should keep them active for the entire duration of recruitment as RRC shall send all recruitment-related communication only through SMS and email. RRC/ER will not entertain any request for change of mobile number and e-mail address at any stage.
- xi) RRC/ER does not accept any responsibility for the candidates not being able to register and/or submit their application within the last day on account of aforesaid reasons or any other reason.
- xii) In case of any difficulty in filling up of online application, please call on the Help Line Number and E-mail ID mentioned on the website of RRC/ER.

14. INVALID APPLICATIONS:

The applications having any of the following deficiencies, discrepancies or irregularities are liable to be rejected:

- i. Applications sent manually and not registered ONLINE.
- ii. Registration of more than one application by the same candidate.
- iii. Applications received after closing date as per schedule.
- iv. Application examination fee not paid or less fee.

- v. Applications which are incomplete or illegible in any manner.
- vi. Application without Date & Thumb impression, Unsigned and Signed in Block or Capital letters may be the cause of rejection of the application
- vii. Application without proper scanned photograph, signature and LTI, other enclosures.
- viii. Application without uploading proper certificates, in respect of Date of Birth, educational qualifications, caste and income, obtained from the appropriate authority in the prescribed format as per Annexure.
- ix. Candidate not possessing the prescribed educational, Scouts & Guides qualifications or Certificates at the time of submitting application.
- x. Overage or date of birth not filled or wrongly filled.
- xi. Photograph not uploaded, black and white photo, photo with cap or sunglasses, disfigured, small size, fullbody, only one side view of the face or unrecognizable photo etc.
- xii. LTI/Signature not uploaded PROPERLY or signature uploaded in capital letters.
- xiii. Any other irregularities which are considered invalid by RRC/ER. Note: - This list is only illustrative and not exhaustive. The applications will be rejected on any other irregularity /deficiency noticed by the RRC/ER at any stage.
- xiv. The application is liable to be rejected if any of the compulsory enclosure is not attached as indicated in the proforma of the application or the application is found defective in any respect.
- xv. No column should be left blank, which also may be the cause of rejection of the application.
- xvi. Discipline should be mentioned in the application. Not mentioning the same may lead to rejection of the application.

15. IMPERSONATION / SUPPRESSION OF FACTS WARNING

- i) Any candidate found using unfair means of any kind in the examination, sending someone else in his/her place to appear in the examination, attempt to impersonate will be debarred from appearing in all the examinations of all the RRBs/RRCs for lifetime. He/she will also be debarred from getting any appointment in the Railways and if already appointed, will be dismissed from service. Such candidates are also liable for legal prosecution.
- ii) Furnishing of any false information to the RRB/RRC or deliberate suppression of any information at any stage will render the candidate disqualified and debarred from appearing at any selection or examination for appointment on the Railways or to any other Government service and if appointed the service of such candidate is liable to be terminated.
- iii) Candidates found submitting forged/fake certificates/documents of any kind for securing eligibility and/or obtaining privileges, including free travel for appearing in the **WRITTEN EXAMINATION/DV** shall lead to rejection of their candidature for the particular recruitment for which he/she has applied. Further, he/she will also be debarred from all examinations conducted by all RRBs/RRCs all over the country for a period of 2 years/for life as deemed fit and legal action will be initiated, if warranted.
- iv) Candidate shall not bring in or attempt to bring in any political or other influence to further his /her interest in respect of the recruitment. Candidature of such candidates is liable to be rejected.

16. IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED:

- iii. As per extant Railway Board instructions, eligible SC/ST candidates who opt for free travel facility shall be issued Free Railway Travel Authority (Second Class/Sleeper Class, as applicable) for attending the Written Examination and Document Verification.
- iv. Kindly ensure to bring e-call letter, Valid and ORIGINAL photo Identification Card (viz. Voter Card, Aadhaar Card, e-Aadhaar, Driving License, PAN Card, Passport, Identity Card issued by his/her Employer in case the candidate is a Government Employee etc.), 4 (Four) Passport size photograph etc. without which the candidate will not be allowed to appear in Written Test.
- v. No TA/DA/Accommodation will be given for appearing in the selection Written Test etc.

- vi. The candidates may be required to stay during the selection Written Tests for 2-3 days for which they have to make their own arrangements.
- vii. The Railway administration reserves the right to fix any date and venue for Written Tests etc., change in venue or postponement of Written Tests etc. for its own convenience, which can also be cancelled due to unforeseen causes against which no request/claim will be entertained.
- viii. Candidates who would be called for Written Test should prepare themselves to attend the same within short notice.
- ix. Non-fulfillment of any of the criteria mentioned in this advertisement will make the application liable for rejection.
